Douglas County Fairgrounds RV Park to reopen May 1, 2020

The Douglas County Board of Commissioners announced that effective May 1, 2020, Douglas County operated RV Parks will reopen to the public on a limited basis. Despite the reopening, we continue encourage residents to stay home and follow the [Governor's Executive Order #20-12](#), 'Stay Home, Save Lives.' However, we do understand the role our outdoor recreational sites provide in keeping our residents mentally and physically healthy. Our parks do have the capacity to allow you to get out and rejuvenate, while remaining dispersed.

Douglas County Fairgrounds RV Park Rules of Social Distancing:

- Physical Distancing of 6 feet will be required at all times.
- Wearing of masks is recommended.
- Be Prepared. Have your own soap, hand sanitizer or disinfectant wipes.
- All picnic tables and other RV Park amenities will not be sanitized.
- Restroom/Showers will be open from 8:00 am to 10:00 am & 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm only
- RV Parks will be open only to Oregonians.

If the use restrictions are not followed, it could lead to the re-closing of our RV Park facilities.

Reminder: A good portion of your safety relies on you, since any public facility is only as clean as the last person who touched it. Please use all our facilities with caution and at your own risk. And make sure you are following the physical distancing and limited use guidelines, so we can continue to keep our parks open.
